

## Policy on Filing Complaints About ACPE Standards

The Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) is the agency that oversees the accreditation of U.S. schools of pharmacy. It is mandated that all schools create a mechanism whereby students can file complaints against a college or school of pharmacy, including tuition and fee policies, and as related to ACPE standards, policies and guidelines that ACPE uses to accredit schools and that those complaints be transmitted to ACPE as well as kept in a file at the school. This file must be available for review by the ACPE accreditation team when they make their site visit.

To comply with this mandate, the West Virginia University School of Pharmacy has put into place the following procedures:
